The Golden Escape!

Finding safety in the midst of chaos is not an experience many people will easily identify with, especially if you are not living in war-torn parts of the world. People who have experienced civil wars or violence can better appreciate what it means to escape death or find protection from imminent calamity. When a person comes to Jesus and open up their hearts in repentance, confess their sins, and accept the forgiveness and redemption of Christ Jesus, they escape the condemnation and damnation that befalls mankind and everyone without Jesus Christ.

Every day many people all over the world are opening up their hearts to Jesus and accepting Him into their hearts. We are happy that you have also opened your heart to Jesus by

pouring out your heart to God, asking for, and receiving his forgiveness and salvation.

Remember the Salvation Prayer:

If you have already accepted Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, you may skip to the next chapter. If not, please consider doing that right now. Jesus died for you to take your place and to give you eternal life. He saved you from eternal condemnation and damnation when He died for you and also rose from the dead (Rom. 5:6-10). He died to redeem you from your sin and from the curse on your life for having broken God's law at one time or the other. He resurrected from the dead to declare you righteous and now acceptable to God. His resurrection from the dead was a proof that all He did on your behalf is true (Isaiah 53:1-6, 1 Corinthians 15:12-20, Romans 10:8-10).

His stripes brought you healing and His resurrection brought you life and Health. Stop cheating yourself and denying yourself the blessing that God has brought to you in Christ Jesus. This is your opportunity!

You can get saved right now and become born again without wasting time. You can become a child of God right now, get your names blotted away from hell and written in the Christ's Book of Life in heaven, and receive eternal life, all as a full package right NOW. It is very simple to do and requires no special ceremony.

Bible says in John 1:12 "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the Right to become children of God, to those who believe in His Name."

Again, Romans 10: 9-10 also says “If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved.”

Now it is your turn to act. Simply say these words to God:

Father, I come to You in the Name of Jesus to confess my sins and to repent of them all. I ask You by the Blood of Jesus to forgive me, wash me and cleanse me of all my sins. Today, I forsake my evil ways and ask You to come into my heart. I believe in You as my Savior, that You died for my sins to redeem me from sin and You rose from the dead to justify me before the Father. Therefore I am

saved. I believe this with my heart and receive Your New Life and Nature of Righteousness into my heart so that I am made right with You. I ask You, dear Lord to grant me Your Precious Holy Spirit and Baptize me with the Holy Ghost and Fire in the Name of Jesus (Matthew 3:11, Acts 1:8). I make this confession with my mouth today by Faith; therefore I am totally saved in Jesus Name (AMEN).

Thank You Lord for Saving Me.

A New Creation

Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NASB)

The moment you acknowledge Jesus as your Savior, something happened to you - the real you, your spirit man, received a new life and become a new person. God gave birth to you anew, and you changed family. You crossed from the satanic lineage to God's family (*John 8:44, John 8:32, Colossians 1:12-14, John 1:12-13*). You came into Christ, you became his very own and bore his name. He is now your Lord and you are co-heir with Him. He is your master, friend, and Father. He becomes all things to you.

According to Jesus, you now have the right to be called a child of God. John 1: 12-13 says *“But as many as received Him,*

to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.” You now have right to access the throne of Grace and speak directly to God as your Father (Romans 5:1, Hebrews 4:14-16). In all sense of it, God is now your Father!

There is now a New Life in you. It is the very Life of God, and that is what qualifies you to be a child of God. The Holy Spirit is assigned that miraculous work and He did that for you the very moment you repented of and confessed your sins and believed in Jesus as your Savior and Lord.

The Bible says in 1 John 5:11-12 that “*And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life.*” And again in 1 John 5:13, it says *These things I*

have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life.”

Friend, what a privilege it is to receive Jesus into our lives and have his life in our heart. What a privilege it is to become his child and be in Christ as a member of his family. You have become a new person; all your sins have been forgiven and your slate is completely wiped new. The person who used to live in your body is dead, a new version of you is now in your body. Your spirit, the real you, is now brand new! Halleluyah to Jesus!

The Old Things Passed Away

Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NASB)

Another very important things that happened to you is that the old things passed away. Halleluyah! What old things is the Bible talking about?

- 1. The Old You:** Before you came to Christ, your spirit was estranged from God, you were dead (Ephesians. 2:1-4). That is, you were cut off from God, and condemned for eternal damnation. The Old you was full of sin and by your nature, you were an enemy of God (Romans 5:10). The Old you bore the image and nature of the fallen Adam and belonged to Satan (John 8:44, Romans 5:12). But all of that is no more. Jesus has changed and replaced that Old You.

2. The Old Life: Before you accepted Jesus Christ as your Savior, the life in you was the life you inherited from the fallen Adam, which he got from the devil (Ephesians 2:1-3, Romans 5:14-19). The wicked and corrupt life. But the moment you came to Jesus, all of that changed. Jesus replaced that life with His own Life. It is called the New Life.

3. The Old Master: Before you came to Jesus, your master was the devil (John 8:44). He was the one lording it over you, and directing the affairs of your life, with or without your permission (2 Corinthians 4:3-4, Ephesians 2:1-3).

4. The Old Ways of Life: Another good news is that when you came to Christ Jesus, the power of the old ways of life over your life was broken and destroyed. You now have the freedom and power to say No! To sin and do only what

pleases God (2 Corinthians 5:16, Romans 6:1-7, 1 Peter 1:23).

5. The Old Ways of Thinking: One other thing that was destroyed the moment you accepted Jesus is the old way of thinking about all things. The old nature thinks like the world does, occupying itself with the cares of this life (Ephesians 2:1-3), 2 John 2:15-17). But now, all that is passed. The New Life in you does only the will of God. God is now the focus of your thought, not the world.

6. The Old Friends: The world is no longer your friend. That also is passed. Your new friends is now Jesus and the people of God. You can no longer maintain friendship with the world, you have no more business with people who don't have same values as that of Christ Jesus. (2 Corinthians 6:14-18, 1 John 2:15-17)

7. The Old Status: Before you came to Jesus, you were an enemy of God, and an object of his wrath (Romans 5:10).

But all that is now passed. Your status has changed from being an enemy to being a friend of God (Romans 5:8-10).

8. The Old Verdict: Condemned! That was what heaven's verdict about you was (John 3:17, Ephesians 2:1-3). You were already condemned because you did not know the Lord. Your destination was going to be hell. But then, mercy found you, and you opened up your heart to Jesus Christ. You know what? The old verdict about you has been torn apart and overturned (Romans 8:1-2). A new verdict has been written for you and it says Justified! Acquitted!

New Things Have Come!

Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NASB)

That moment that you opened up your heart to Jesus, everything became New. You received the New Birth, among other things. Halleluyah! What are these New things that have come to you?

1. **The New Birth:** You are now born again. You now have the New Life. Bible says your birth is new, you have been born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. Yes! (John 1:12-13) God has given birth to you, you now have the Life of God imparted to you.

You have been spiritually born by God through Jesus Christ, with a new life and spirit (John 3:3-6).

2. **The New You:** If you read the verse above again, you will see the word 'behold'. That is the word that describe you now. Everyone that sees you now cannot but take a second look because they can see the change. The Presence of Christ in your life is making a great difference. And people will start talking about it because you are simply New! You have changed! Something to behold! All things have become new (Ephesians 5:8, Matthew 5:14-15).

3. **The New Family:** You now have a New Family, the very family of God. God is now your Father. Jesus is now your joint-heir. You are an adopted child of God. He paid the price for you to become His own by His own Life. He went

to Cross and paid the price with His Life to make that happen (Colossians 1:11-14, Ephesians 3;15, John 1:12).

4. **The New Spirit:** You have now received a New Spirit - the Spirit of God is now resident in your own brand new spirit. He is there to help you live the New Life. God has given you His own Spirit to help you live the Christ kind of life, a life above reproach, an exemplary life to others (Romans 8: 8-10, 14, 16).

5. **The New Company:** Part of the New things that have come is your acceptance into the Body of Christ. You now belong to the company of God's people (Acts 4:23). The local church is the closest expression of that. You must find a Bible believing church where the Word of God is rightly taught to attend (1Corinthians 10.17, Romans 12:4-5, Hebrews 10:25).

6. **The New Way of Life:** Faith is now your New Way of Life.

God expects you to emulate Jesus and walk as Jesus walked.

That is your new way of life. Jesus is your New Model

(Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11, Hebrews 10:38, 1John 2:3-6).

7. **The New Way of Thinking:** God has also given you the

mind of Christ. It is part of the gift you received. To

appropriate that, you will need to spend time meditating in

God's Word (1Corinthians 2:16, Philippians 2:5-8, Romans

12:1-2, Philippians 4:8).

8. **The New Relationship:** God has called you into a Father-

son relationship and to sustain that, you need to have a daily

fellowship with Him through His Word, prayers and Praises

(John 1:12, 1John 1:7, Hebrews 4:14-16, Joshua 1:8).

9. **The New Leadership:** You now have God as your New

Lead and master. Imagine how privilege you are! He said in

Psalm 32:8 that he will instruct you and teach you in the way which you should go; He will counsel you with My eye upon you (NASB). The Living Bible puts like this: *I will instruct you (says the Lord) and guide you along the best pathway for your life; I will advise you and watch your progress. (TLB)*

10. **The New Anointing:** Now you have access to the Anointing. Even though many don't know this when they accept Jesus. The Anointing of the Holy Spirit has been given to you for service. It is called the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. As you pray and worship God, you may find yourself speaking in a heavenly tongue. It is a God-given language for prayer and praising God. The Anointing of the Holy Spirit becomes very evident in your life as you faithfully serve in your local church and bring others to Christ Jesus (Acts 1:8, Acts 2:38-39, 1John 2:20, 27, John 7:37-39, Matthew 3:11).

11. **The New Assignment:** You have a New Assignment, and it is to bring others to Christ. Your new call and duty is to tell others about the salvation that is in Christ Jesus and share your own testimonies with them. You preach the Gospel to them and let the Holy Spirit complete in them also the work of salvation (2Corinthians 5:18-21, 2Timothy 4:2, 5, Matthew 5:14-16, Romans 12:4-6). Everything is now completely New!

Welcome to your Newly found freedom and life in Christ Jesus (Galatians 5:1, 13, Galatians 2:20). You have been set free from the old life that entangles and keep people in bondage. You are now a part of the greatest family in heaven and earth – the Family of God.
